C. 2 3/8" X 12" X 16": up to 8 lines; 28 letters & spaces per line = \$500

II. CLASSROOM SPONSORSHIP: Your Name on a Classroom (NOTE: Up to FIVE Names Per Classroom to Aide in the Furnishing of Each Room)

A. 34 Standard Classrooms = \$5000 each

B. 8 Science/Computer Labs, Building Trades, etc. = \$10,000 each

C. 7 Band Hall, Ag Shop, Home Economics, Library, Administration, etc. = 15,000 each
